









Separation and Disposal of Household Garbage

April 2020

- Place garbage in the designated bags and write your name on them.
- Garbage in bags other than the designated bags and in bags with no name on them will not be collected.
- Please dispose of garbage by 8:30 a.m. on collection day. Do not put garbage out the night before collection day.
- Dispose your garbage at the designated garbage station located in your area.
- Empty cans, empty bottles, plastic PET bottles and Styrofoam will be recycled, so do not put cigarette butts or other garbage in them.

Burnable Garbage	<p>Kitchen scraps, shells (small), magazines, books, paper scraps, newspapers, cardboard (size to fit in a designated bag), clothes, blankets, stuffed toys, cushions, aluminum foil, dry grass, dead leaves, food scraps, paper cups, disposable diapers, shoes, pillows, aluminum foil snack bags, rice bags, pieces of wood (less than 50 cm)</p>  <p>Box lunch containers, disposable plates, shopping bags, cassette tapes, toothbrushes, toothpaste tubes, shampoo containers, bleach containers, pudding containers, leather, rubber items, vinyl pipes (length to fit in a designated bag), plastic containers</p> 	Mondays, Wednesdays, Fridays	
Non-burnable Garbage (Empty Cans, Others)	<p>Empty cans, glass items, pots, kettles, portable gas stoves, gas cassettes, kitchen knives, sickles, other metal items that fit in a designated bag. (Excluding agricultural machine parts, etc. Spray cans should be completely emptied and pierced.)</p>  <p>Crockery, umbrellas, small home electronics (cut off the cords), cameras, dry-cell batteries, fluorescent lights, light bulbs, wires, vinyl covered cords, metal wires, glasses, watches, telephones, lighters. (Place nails in a small bag so as to not move loosely and put the bag in a designated bag.)</p> 	Thursdays	
Empty Bottles	 <p>Remove the caps from bottles and place them together with empty cans. Rinse the insides lightly before disposing.</p>	Tuesdays	
Plastic PET Bottles	<p>Bottles of alcoholic drinks, soy sauce, "mirin" cooking wine, barley tea, oolong tea, soft drinks, drinking water, etc.</p> <p>(Bottles with the PET mark )</p>  <p>Remove the caps from bottles, rinse inside lightly, and crush them flat with your foot (to fit more into the designated bag).</p>	Styrofoam <p>Styrofoam containers Styrofoam food trays Rinse inside lightly.</p> 	Tuesdays

*For disposal of the following oversized garbage and garbage that cannot fit in a designated bag, please bring them into the Clean Center after separating them.

Oversized Garbage	<p>Furniture (remove any metal), business-related cardboard, mattresses (remove spring units), tatami mats, bicycles, tricycles, 18-liter drums (empty drums), heaters, kotatsu (Japanese foot warmers), futons, carpets, gas stoves, electric griddles</p>

Garbage Collection Days in Wadomari Town

* As shown above, please separate the garbage into five categories: "Burnable Garbage", "Non-burnable Garbage (Empty Cans, Others)", "Empty Bottles", "Plastic PET Bottles", and "Styrofoam". Dispose of them in separate designated bags on the respective designated day.

Non-burnable Garbage (Empty Cans, Others)			Thu	Rinse empty tinned food cans before disposing.	
Empty Bottles		Tue		Remove bottle caps and dispose of them separately from the bottles.	
Plastic PET Bottles		Tue		Remove the lid and label and place them in burnable garbage.	
Styrofoam		Tue		Rinse before disposing.	

The following garbage items are not handled by the Clean Center.

- Tires, batteries
- LP gas cylinders, fire extinguishers
- Motorcycles, automobiles, boilers
- Live trees, green grass, nonconforming agricultural products
- A large amount of scrap metal
- Soil, stones, concrete debris, etc.
- Scrap materials, waste oils, inflammable materials
- Agricultural waste vinyl, used agricultural chemical containers

Industrial Waste is not handled by the Clean Center.

- Construction scrap materials, woodchips
 - Scrap metals, animal carcasses
 - Other business-related waste
- *Self-processing of industrial waste is required by law.

- A fee is required for disposal of oversized garbage / business-related waste: ¥10/kg
- A fee is required for disposal of household garbage brought directly into the Clean Center: ¥5/kg
- The Clean Center is closed on **Sundays** and from **December 31 to January 3**.
- Hours for brought-in garbage at the Clean Center: **until 5:00 p.m. on weekdays, 3:00 p.m. on Saturdays and holidays**
